CONCEPT NOTE

Heritage has always been an indispensible asset for mankind since time immemorial. However, the idea of creating an international movement for protecting heritage emerged after World War I, to preserve cultural sites and conserve nature. It all began when the Abu Simbel Temples were threatened with the construction of the Aswan High Dam in Egypt. After an appeal from the governments of Egypt and Sudan, UNESCO launched an international safeguarding campaign. Though the campaign cost about US\$80 million, it showed the importance of solidarity and the nations' shared responsibility in conserving outstanding cultural sites. In view of this, UNESCO initiated, with the help of the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), the preparation of a draft convention on the protection of cultural heritage.

This led to the World Heritage Convention of 1972, which was indeed a significant landmark, because it was through this convention that the horizons of 'Heritage' as a concept expanded to include nature conservation and the preservation of cultural properties. And therefore, it is this ethos put forth by the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in 1972, that Kaash

Foundation echoes and validates:

'Considering that, in a society where living conditions are changing at an accelerated pace, it is essential for man's equilibrium and development to preserve for him a fitting setting in which to live, where he will remain in contact with nature and the evidences of civilization bequeathed by past generations, and that, to this end, it is appropriate to give the cultural and natural heritage an active function in community life and to integrate into an overall policy the achievements of our time, the values of the past and the beauty of nature'.

For the first time in 1978, UNESCO inscribed 12 World Heritage Sites. And today, with an increased awareness to preserve, conserve and protect these magnificent areas, UNESCO has declared 1121 World Heritage Sites globally, out of which, 38 are in India and three are in Mumbai. Therefore, enacting on the UNESCO's endeavour to celebrate the World Heritage Week 2020 from 19th November to 25th November, Kaash Foundation wishes to initiate a series of week long events under its Heritage Vertical with the aim:

 To foster in the youth a sense of shared responsibility towards our shared heritage.

 To bring together scholars with an expertise in heritage, to discuss and deliberate over the issues, concerns and varied dimensions that the field has adopted over the years.

 To provide our traditional folk artists with a forum to showcase their legacy, thus encouraging the intangible aspect of our heritage.
 To create awareness and promote UNESCO's ideologies in India.






